

Boys Hostel Rules & Regulations:

- Hostel seats are allotted to the students based on their academic records and class attendance (he must have 75% class attendance).
- Allotted hostel seat may be canceled if any student is non-collegiate (attendance below 75%) and dis-collegiate (attendance below 60%) in running semester.
- Female students are not allowed in the male hostel and vice-versa.
- Guests or relatives are allowed to stay maximum 24 hours in the hostel with the permission of hostel superintendent.
- All boarders of a room or hostel shall jointly and/or as a whole be responsible for any loss/damage of the property of the hostel. Any damage/breakage to hostel property will be charged to the occupants of the room/ block with a fine.
- Boarders shall not use any electrical appliances such as electric heaters, electric stoves etc. in their rooms. However, boarders may use computers and music systems in their rooms. Boarders shall not leave water flowing from taps. Boarders on leaving their rooms shall always switch off the lights and fans
- Students must avoid singing aloud, shouting or making all types of noises.
- Hostel premises cannot be used for any kind of political activities. Permission may be given for cultural program.
- Boarders are expected to keep their rooms clean, tidy and maintain cleanliness. No rubbish should be thrown into the wash basin, drain, corridors or outside the rooms or in the surroundings. The bins kept for this purpose should be used.
- The students are advised not to keep large amount of cash or valuables in the room. The student is responsible for the safety of his belongings inside the room.
- Boarders shall submit a list of their personal belongings to the hostel superintendent. In case of transferring those belongings from hostel boarders must take permission of the hostel super.
- Boarders shall bring necessary things like curtain, bedding by their own.
- Substance abuse, consumption of alcohol and smoking or chewing of tobacco and its related products is strictly banned in the hostels and in campus.
- Ragging in any form is banned inside and outside the campus. Strict action will be taken against the defaulters. No leniency will be shown to the offenders. Suspension and/or withdrawal from the hostel/ institute are one of the actions taken promptly.

Important Rules during COVID-19 regarding Health Issues:

- Wearing face cover at all times and at all place during your stay inside campus. Thereby carry appropriate number of masks with you.
- Frequent hand washing with soap and use hand sanitizer, even when hands are not visibly dirty.

- Crowding/gatherings must be avoided without permission. Cultural activities, meetings etc. are not allowed during this pandemic situation.
- Those having symptoms of fever, cough or difficulty in breathing are required to report immediately to the health officer at NITER medical center.
- Self-monitoring of health should be done by all the hostel inmates and reporting any illness at the earliest.
